Agentic AI and the Future of Work

Most organizations report using AI, yet see no meaningful bottom-line impact. Why? Because most AI use cases are simply bolted onto existing workflows rather than rethinking the workflows themselves.

The cutting-edge AI agents represent a step change. These agents can work across systems, reason through ambiguity, and interact with people—not just as tools, but as collaborators. This raises a fundamental question for executives: How should decisions be made, workflow, and humans engage with software that can act autonomously?

We will learn frameworks and examples for redesigning work to maximize value and minimize risk from AI and apply them directly to participants' own contexts.
