I am pleased to share the career outcomes of the MIM Class of 2024, which demonstrate the programme's success in preparing graduates for competitive early-career roles worldwide. 95% of students received job offers within three months of graduation, launching careers across a wide range of sectors and locations.

Demand for pre-experience talent remains strong globally, with multinational corporations actively seeking young professionals who align culturally with their companies' international footprint and strategy.

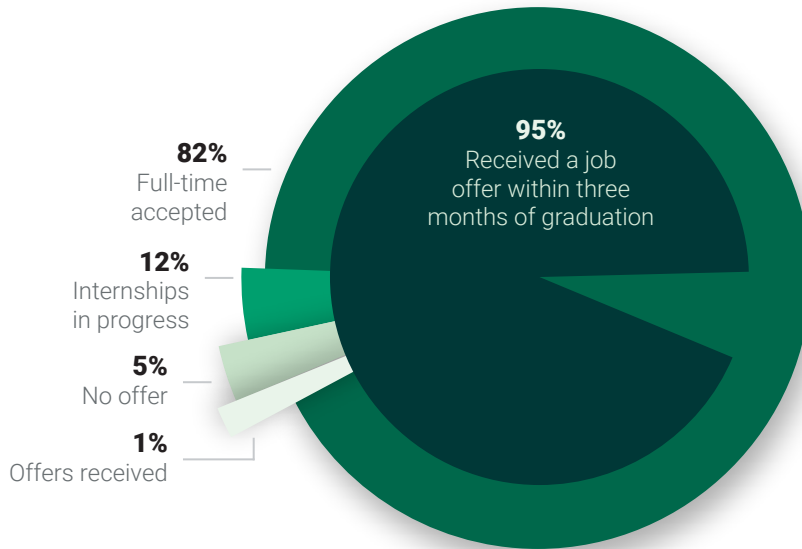
While 32% of graduates entered Management Consulting, others joined the Technology, Media and Telecom sector (30%), corporate roles (21%), and Financial Services (17%). These broad outcomes

reflect the value of a strong general management foundation, combining data fluency, sustainability awareness, and cross-functional collaboration.

Opportunities spanned 33 countries, showcasing both the global reach of INSEAD's network and the graduates' readiness to contribute across cultures. The outcomes also speak to the career management skills honed during the programme: self-assessment, strategic planning, and the agility to pursue emerging opportunities.

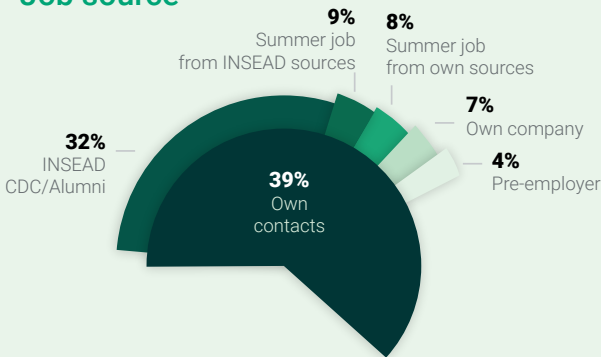

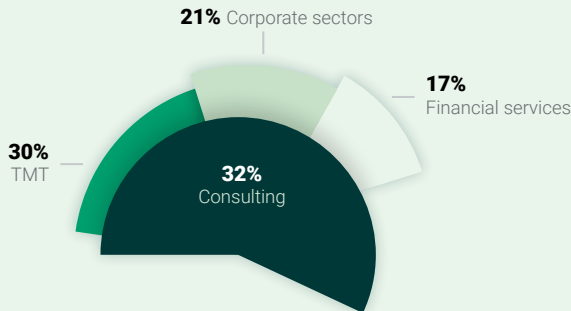

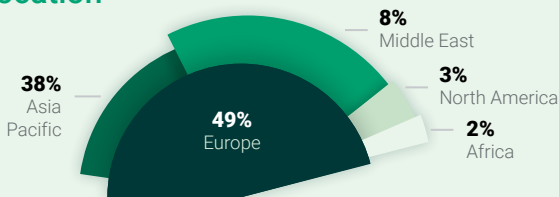
Job source



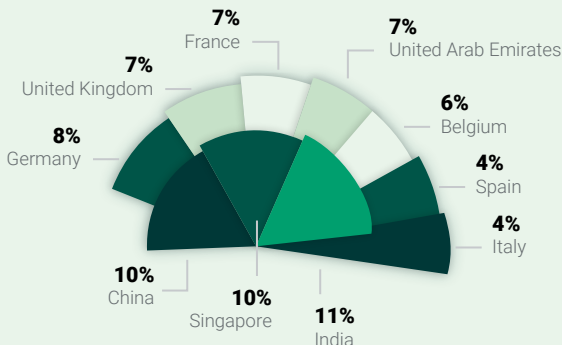
Sector breakdown

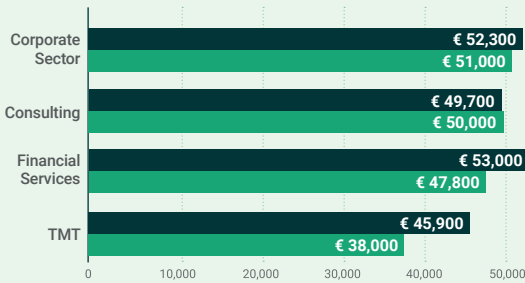

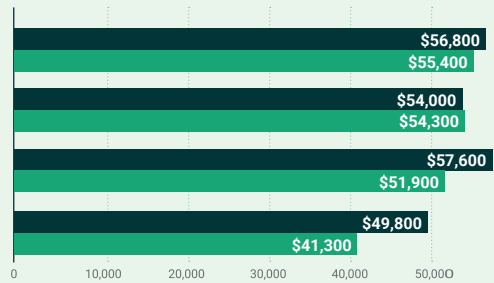

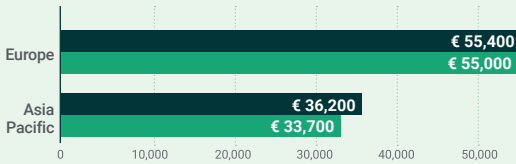

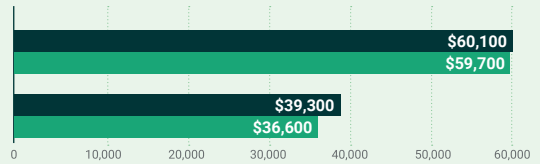

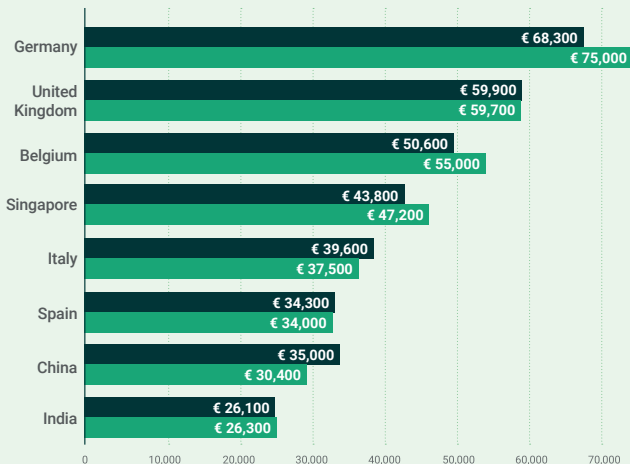

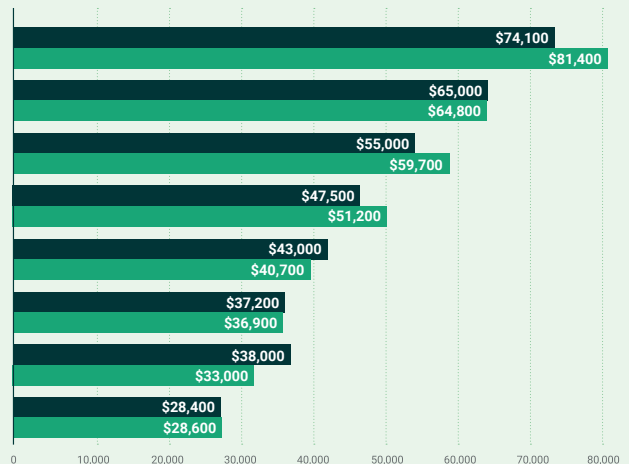

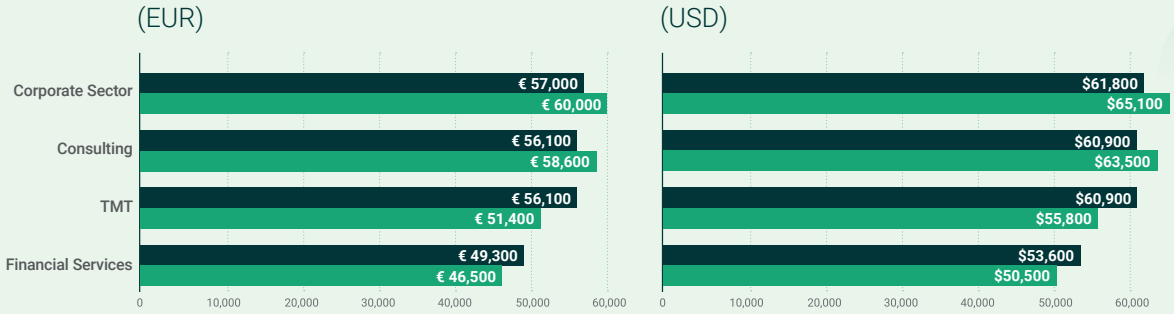

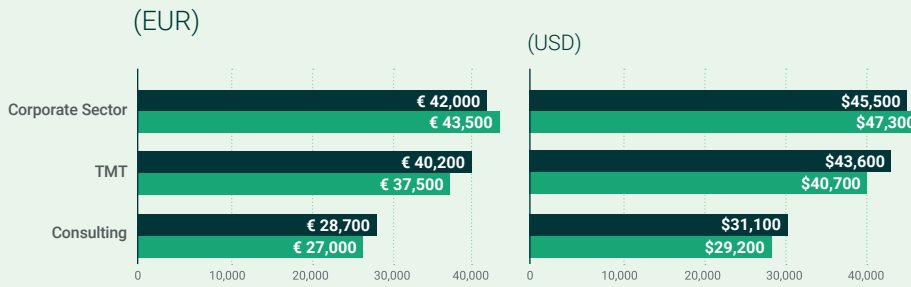
